As you probably know, the 118th Monon Bell Classic is this Saturday in Greencastle. Wabash is going for its third straight victory in the *Oldest Continuous Rivalry West of the Alleghenies*. The Little Giants are 9-0 and ranked 9th nationally in Division III football. After last Saturday's NCAC championship victory over Wittenberg, Wabash is headed again to the Division III playoffs – currently seeded 2nd in the North Region.

But 4-4 DePauw, winners of its last three games, stands in the way. And, as the cliché goes, you can throw out the record book in this rivalry: witness Wabash's 47-0 dismantling of undefeated DPU last year in Crawfordsville.

For those of you fortunate enough to head to Saturday's game, here's a few tidbits to help you in Greencastle:

1. Wabash fans are asked to wear white Saturday for a Wabash White Out in support of the Little Giants in their white traveling uniforms.
2. Parking lots at Blackstock Stadium open at 9 a.m. – cost is \$5 per vehicle. RV parking will be in the Peeler Art Center parking lot, just south of the Center. The lot will open at 8:00 a.m. – no overnight parking will be allowed.
3. Gates to the stadium open at 11:30 a.m. prior to the 1:00 p.m. kickoff, but there is no re-entry once you're inside Blackstock. Plan ahead.
